

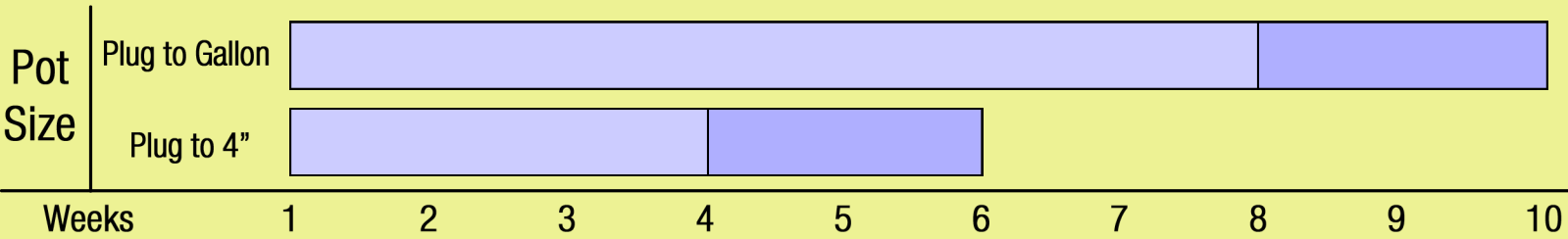

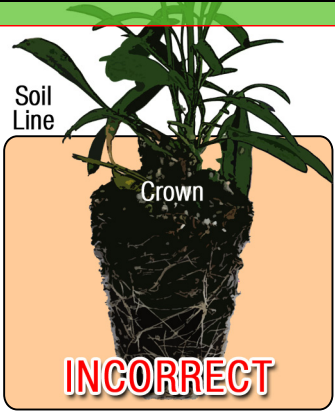
HEUCHERELLA 'SOLAR POWER'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

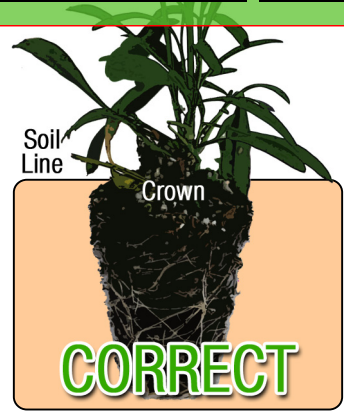
 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.6 - 6.8	Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM	EC: 0.6 - 0.9
Light Levels: Sun to shade	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.	
Habit: Mounding	<u>Diseases</u> : Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. Note : All Heucherella are rust resistant.	
Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Description

Large, red centered, yellow spring leaves change to lime green with red centers in the summer warm months. Combines with red flowering annuals and perennials for multi-seasonal interest. Creates a focal point anywhere it is planted. Airy white flowers are produced in spring.
