

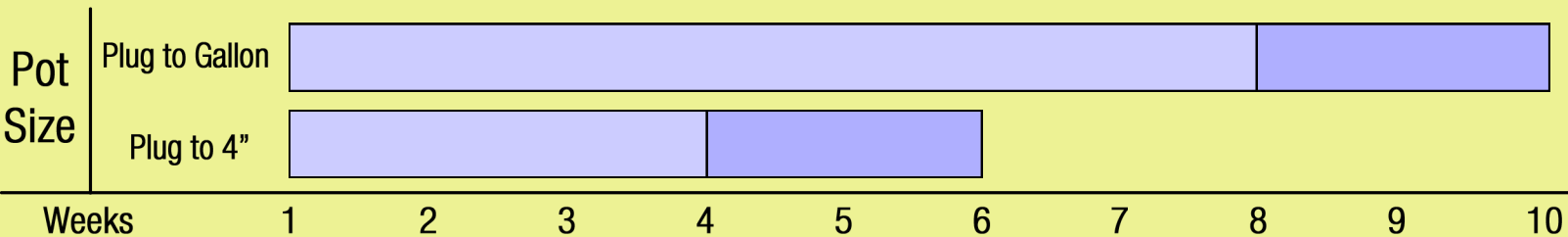

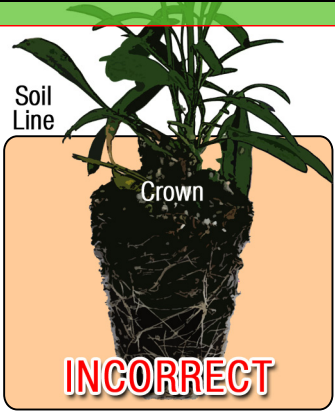

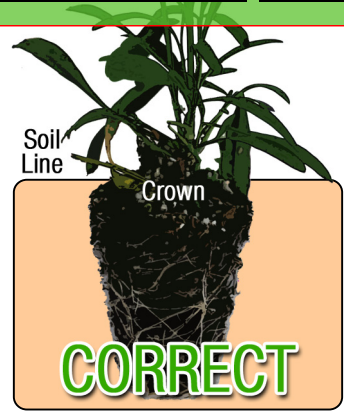

pH: 5.8 - 6.2	Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM	EC: 0.6 - 0.9
Light Levels: Sun to part shade	Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings	
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9	Possible Problems: <u>Insect</u> : Root weevils, foliar nematodes are a problem in some areas <u>Diseases</u> : Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.
