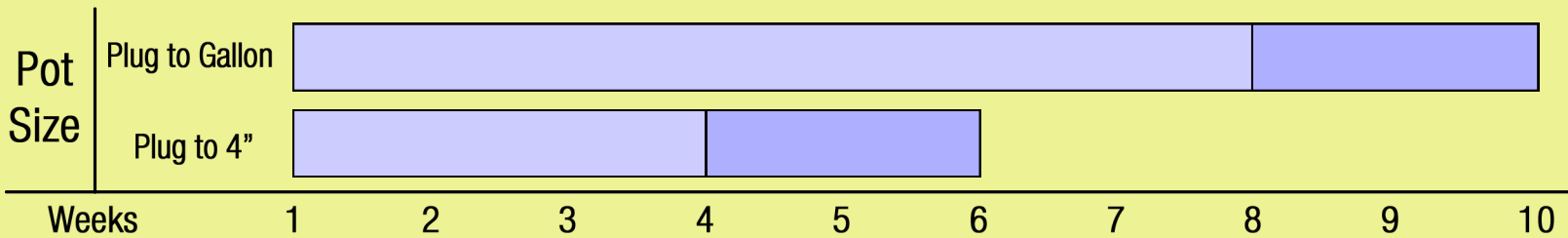

## Approximate Finish Time From Liner

□ = Minimum □ = Maximum



pH: 5.8 - 6.2

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

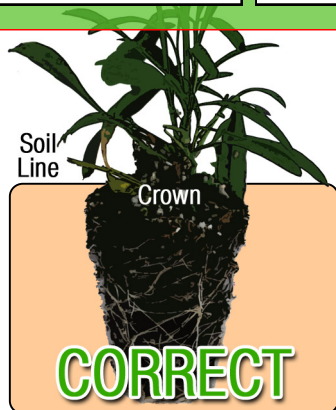
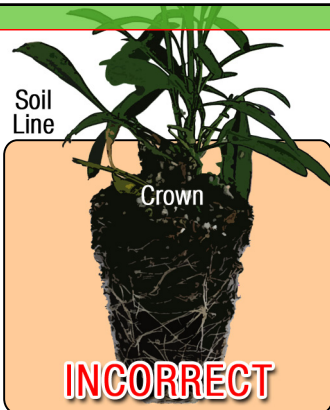
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas. Watch for root weevils.

Habit: Mounding

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture. Powdery mildew, rust, and leaf spots may occur.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Bred for heat and humidity tolerance. In spring, large peach colored leaves with a showy silver overlay accent the lush habit. Foliage color intensifies to rose purple with a decorative frosted veil in fall and winter. Great landscape specimen for North America.
